Troop 63 will be using Winkler Lodge at Kittatinny Mountain Scout Reservation in Sandyston NJ as home base for the January 11 – 13, 2008 winter sports weekend. Scouts and adults will spend Saturday at Shawnee Mountain Ski Resort in the Poconos, where the activities will include skiing, snowboarding and tubing. If you're not especially athletic or adventurous, you can spend the day sipping hot chocolate in front of a roaring fire at Shawnee's lodge. If there is enough interest, we may also plan some activities at KMSR for campers who don't want to hit the slopes at Shawnee.

Each patrol is responsible for buying their own food, arranging transportation for themselves and their patrol gear and securing an adult to attend to supplement the troop adult leadership. The attached permission slip, along with \$10.00 food money in exact cash, must be returned to your patrol leader no later than Thursday, January 3, 2008 if you want to attend. **Also, please fill out and return the separate "Troop 63 Ski Trip" flyer if you plan on skiing, snowboarding or tubing at Shawnee Mountain. Note that there is an additional charge for those activities, based on a group-size of at least 15 people. If we have fewer than 15 skiers/snowboarders in our group, the prices will be higher.**
